How to get there

By rail: The ICC is minutes away from Birmingham New Street Station,

the UK's largest interchange station. Regular services connect you to London (100 minutes away), Edinburgh (4hrs 30 mins),

Cardiff (2hrs) and most other regional towns and cities throughout the UK.

By road: Birmingham is at the hub of a comprehensive motorway network

that connects you to every corner of the country via the M5, $\,$ M6,

M40 and M42. Furthermore you can benefit from over 2,000
