Current position

- 2006-2008 programme extended until Dec 08 - funded from carry forward.
- Secretary of State has agreed in principle.
- Full details and extended programme agreed in Summer
- First year (2008-2009) funds transferred summer 2008.
- Funds for 2009-2011 agreed late summer www.idea.gov.uk

Shaping the extended programme

Programme will need to respond to how environment changes

- Health inequalities strategy
- Working effectively with RIEPs
- Other national programmes e.g. NST
- Changing emphasis but maintained focus overall on capacity building and improvement/self improvement.

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Learning from the first programme

- Demand for 'classic' IDeA programmes is slowing down and new approaches are in demand.
- Still a demand for learning from what others are doing.
- LAs want improvement support that reflects their partnership roles.
- Demand for individualised support growing

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Our own development ambitions

- A programme fully integrated into the other Agency offers.
- A programme working in partnership with other national stakeholders.
- A programme focussed on supporting the sector to achieve the health outcomes it desires.

 Supporting councils to tackle health inequalities and secure better health outcomes for their communities

- Supporting improvement via work with individual councils.
- Developing and sharing knowledge and learning from improvement.
- Facilitating sharing peer to peer.
- The LA workforce as health advocates
- Helping councils engage with the developing health policy agenda.

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• Supporting Members in their health improvement and health leadership roles.

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- National and local leadership development training and events.
- Widening our approach to include NEDs
- Work with Social Care and Scrutiny teams to integrate support offer to councils and Members.

 Support Councils to achieve improvements in effectiveness and efficiency through health improvement programmes.

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- Some initial work this year but largely a new area.
- Impact assess and evaluate the programme itself.
- Support LAs in impact assessing their own HI programmes
- Develop the 'business case' for health improvement

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 Support the local government sector by promoting its role in health and well being to Government and key stakeholders

- Raising the profile of council's lead role in health improvement.
- Celebrating achievement and best practice via award sponsorship
- Stimulating debate
- Supporting the LGA in developing the voice of the sector
- Develop effective relationships with stakeholder organisations that benefit the sector
