Item Action by

Welcome and Introductions

Baroness Eaton welcomed colleagues to the meeting of the Forum and introduced the Minister for Decentralisation, Rt. Hon. Greg Clark MP.

The Minister indicated that he would like to hear about some of the LGA's business prior to his presentation and so the Chairman agreed to progress through Items 2 - 4 first.

1 Localism

Members received a presentation from the Minister, which outlined the Government's decentralisation programme, its initiatives and key actions essential for success.

The Minister acknowledged the challenges facing the sector and outlined the importance of sharing best practice at both a local level and with Central Government. Members received details of the proposed timescale and were invited to respond to the consultation, providing comment on any issues including statutory requirements.

The Minister invited questions from the Forum and Members raised several issues which were addressed in turn. It was suggested that, further to the Localism Bill's Royal Assent, a joint event might be held as a briefing opportunity.

The Chairman thanked the Minister for his presentation and for enabling the opportunity for discussion.
