That the General Assembly hears motions on Climate Change (Item 8) (proposed by Lichfield District Council) and Icelandic Banks (Item 9) (proposed by Daventry District Council) and then remits these Motions to the LGA Environment Board and LGA Executive respectively for detailed discussion.

Motions from Member Authorities

Background

1. Eight member authorities submitted motions on four issues of national importance to local government for consideration at the Annual Meeting of the General Assembly.
2. The LGA Executive, at its meeting on 21 May selected the two motions set out at Items 6 and 7 for debate at the General Assembly. The Executive also agreed that the motions on climate change (Item 8) and Icelandic Banks (Item 9) should be heard by the General Assembly and then remitted to the Environment Board and LGA Executive respectively for detailed discussion.
