# Item Decisions and actions Action

# 1 Welcome, Apologies & Declarations of Interest

The Chairman welcomed members to the meeting and in particular, the new members who had joined the Board since July.

Apologies were received from Cllr Judi Billing.

There were no declarations of interest.

# 2 Note of the Previous Meeting

Cllr Nigel Ashton suggested that the 87 Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) the IIB were responsible for monitoring were too numerous to properly consider and that it was not possible to draw out the ones that were important and their impact. In response, the Board heard that the 87 KPIs were a requirement of the grant agreement with Government and it was important for the Board to be aware of progress against the agreement as this was the way that DLUHC were monitoring progress and holding the LGA accountable. Officers agreed to consider how Cllr Ashton's suggestion could be addressed going forward.

# **Decision:**

The minutes of the previous meeting held on 29 July 2021 were **agreed** as a correct record.

#### Action:

Officers to consider how to balance the need to report back to DLUHC against the 87 KPIs and the need for the Board to be able to assess the impact of the programme against a smaller set of measures.

# 3 Membership, terms of reference and board priorities for 2021/22

Dennis Skinner introduced the item explaining that whilst this Board was one of nine that reported to the LGA's Executive Advisory Board, it had some unique characteristics including independent members.



In recent years, Government had been much more prescriptive in the LGA's use of its improvement grant and this year had seen the Government effectively contract the LGA to deliver a programme of work that they wished to purchase. The recent reshuffle was an opportunity for officers to lobby for increased flexibility to allow the LGA to be appropriately responsive to the needs to the sector. Clarity was being sought on the Minister that would hold the local government brief.

An induction for new Members of the Board, as well as a refresher for existing Members, was planned and details would be circulated outside of the meeting once finalised.

# **Decision:**

Improvement & Innovation Board **noted** its membership; **agreed** its Terms of Reference; and **noted** its priorities for the coming year.

In respect of those Councils who were seeing boundary issues following the establishment of Integrated Care Systems over different geographies than their Council boundaries, the LGA were actively engaging Councils affected and seeing what support they could be offered.
